#### **End of Year Giving**

We are all looking forward to putting 2020 behind us. This year, because the COVID 19 pandemic has affected so many not-for-profits, the rules about deductions have changed. For individual donors, the adjusted gross income (AGI) limit for cash contributions was increased for individual donors. You can now deduct cash contributions made in 2020 up to 100 percent of your AGI (increased from 60 percent). If you are able, please consider the CWC in your Year End Giving plans.
